2010 MOUNTAIN STATE FOREST FESTIVAL JURIED FINE ART EXHIBIT

Hosted by the Randolph County Community Arts Center and the Seneca Trail Artists Guild

Eligibility

Resident West Virginians, 18 years of age or older and not still in high school, may submit two (2) entries. *(Persons under 18 or in grades K-12, please check **Student Show** on form.)* Works must have been created in last two years.

Media

All forms of painting, drawing, collage, hand pulled prints and sculpture will be accepted. Works must not have been exhibited in a previous Forest Festival Art Exhibit or RCCAC/Great Hall exhibit. All work must be original fine art, no copies or computer generated art. Hanging work is not to exceed 4x6 feet; sculpture weight limit, 40 lbs. All entries should be family friendly. The RCCAC reserves the right to reject pieces not conforming to the above categories; such works will be reviewed by receiving judges and/or the juror, prior to entry. However, acceptance of work does not guarantee hanging of all pieces. This is a juried show and the number of works included will be dictated by available space.

Juror

Jean K. Gill of Virginia is an artist and educator. 2010 marks her 19th year as a watercolor instructor for Fairfax County Public Schools Adult and Community Education program. She has served on the Board of the Virginia Watercolor Society, as an officer of Potomac Valley Watercolorists, and as chapter president of the Delta Kappa Gamma Society International Honor Society of Professional Women Educators. She is a member of AWS and NWS.

Entry Fee

Non-member-\$30/non-refundable fee for two entries; STAG and RCCAC Members-\$15/non-refundable fee for two entries. *Student Show entries are \$2 each. Make checks payable to RCCAC. Visa, Mastercard and Discover accepted.*

Submission of Entries

Hand-delivered entries only, accepted Saturday, October 2, 2010 at the Randolph County Community Arts Center, corner of Randolph Avenue and Park Street (former St. Brendan Catholic Church) between 1-3 p.m.

Condition of Entries

All paintings, including student work, **must be framed**, suitably wired for hanging with **identification labels attached to back** and under glass or Plexiglas, if applicable. No saw toothed hangers! Oil paintings on stretched canvas **should be wired** and have finished edges. No exceptions.

No arrangements can be made for storage. **Artists and students whose work hung in the exhibit but was not juried in for the extended exhibit** must pick up their work on Sunday, Oct. 10 from 1:00 - 3:00 p.m.

Liability

Entries will be handled and displayed with all reasonable care. The Seneca Trail Artists Guild, Randolph County Community Arts Center and/or the Mountain State Forest Festival will not be responsible for loss or damage from any cause whatsoever. Insurance is the responsibility of the artist. Work should not be so fragile that shipment or public display is potentially harmful.

Sales
